By visiting this one page, parents will be able to view the September Home Package documents, and additional site specific documents, in one place, on their school's website.

A link to this page will be placed on the home page of each school website by ITS. Schools are also requested to create a news post on their school website during the first week of school drawing parents' attention to the link and the 2014-15 School Year Information page itself.

City of Kitchener/Waterloo Maps

The City of Kitchener and Waterloo – Walking to School flyers will not arrive at school sites during the last week of August. Instead, the maps will be available for parents to view electronically in colour on the School Year Information link found on school websites.

Immunization Post Card

The immunization post card provided by the Region of Waterloo Public Health will not be included in the September Home Package this year. Instead, schools will be requested to distribute the post card closer to suspension time in December or January.

Off-Campus Consent Forms

Do not include off-campus forms in the September Home Package. Blanket permission forms are not permitted. Each time a student participates in an offcampus activity, parents/guardians should always be aware. Parents/Guardians must always be informed of the date/time/location/activities during off-campus activities, to ensure that informed consent is obtained. Region of Waterloo Public Health

During the first week of June schools will receive a package from Public Health containing forms to be distributed as follows:

<u>JK – 6 schools</u>

Form A – Instructions for distribution of forms received

Form B – Elementary Immunization Update – to be distributed to all Junior, Senior Kindergarten and Grade 1 students in September

Form E – Student Immunization Form – to be completed by new registrations and students new to the Region

JK – 8, 7 – 8 schools

Form C – Information for Parents about the Health Care Consent Act – these letters may be distributed to all grade 7 & 8 students in September or two weeks prior to your school's immunization clinic. Two weeks prior to your school's vaccination clinic, all grade 7 & 8 students will receive the following forms:

- Hepatitis B Vaccination consent to Gr 7 students
- Meningococcal Vaccination consent to Gr 7 students
- HPV Vaccination consent to Gr 8 girls

Schools are requested to distribute these forms to the appropriate students. All forms completed by parents are to be returned to the **main office**. The returned forms will be collected by the Region of Waterloo Public Health prior to the first round of vaccination clinics starting the second week in September.
